

Healing Farms Camp ABILITY

Healing Farms is a local non-profit that provides adult day services and supports to individuals with intellectual disabilities and their families. Camp ABILITY is a summer day camp designed for individuals with intellectual disabilities ages 17+. It provides the opportunity for your young adult to not only have fun and form new friendships, but also the opportunity to stretch, grow, and build life skills resulting in a greater level of independence. Camp ABILITY offers a variety of fun activities both on our urban farm and out in the community.

Camp Sessions & Themes

West Ashley Main Campus – Camp times 9:00 am – 4:00pm

Session 1: 06/08/26 – 06/12/26 *Cooking/The Garden* - Explore your community and build life skills through cooking and food. Activities may include touring a bakery, visiting a local farm, and more.

Session 2: 06/15/26 – 06/19/26 *Arts/Crafts/Building* - Explore and create with a variety of activities ranging from clay and paint to a repurposed build project.

Session 3: 06/22/26 – 06/26/26 *Recreation/Leisure* - Fun, teamwork, and social skills are the main objectives. Activities and games may include bowling, water games, swimming, and nature walks.

Moncks Corner Camp - Camp times 9:00 am – 3:00pm

06/22/26 – 06/26/26 - This week will feature a variety of activities such as cooking, visiting local farms, the arts and creativity, as well as numerous recreation opportunities that may include bowling, nature walks, water games, and swimming.

Camp Fees & Hours

Registration fees include all activities and daily snacks. Enrollment for camp is limited and is offered first come first served. Campers must bring a water bottle, extra clothes and their own lunch each day. Cost is - \$195 per week. Camp hours are 9:00 am - 4:00 pm. Extended stay is available.

Multiple-Week Campers

Campers who sign up for two or more weeks will receive a discount of \$10 off each additional week.

Extended Stay

Extended care is available at the West Ashley location from 8:00 am –9:00 am and 4:00 pm - 5:00pm for an additional \$20 per week for either morning or afternoon; or \$35 per week for both sessions

Cancellations

Cancellations must be submitted via email no later than two weeks prior to camp to receive a refund minus a \$50 nonrefundable deposit. No refunds will be given for cancellations within 2 weeks of the camp date.

Eligibility

Participants must be able to cooperate in-group activities and have manageable behavior and health care needs to the level of the staff's training. Participants must be able to feed and toilet themselves and express their basic needs either verbally or non-verbally. New campers must attend a Healing Farms tour prior to camp to help determine eligibility.
